Snack



Children in Reception and Class 1 continue to receive a free snack at break time as part of the Government Fruit and Veg Scheme. Children in Class 2 may bring in a healthy snack from home. Please can this be fruit or veg rather than fruit /cereal bars. Thank you.

Walking home – Year 4 children only

Children in Year 4 are permitted to walk home independently with written permission. Please email admin@acomb.northumberland.sch.uk stating your permission. If we already have your permission, you don't need to do anything. We would also ask that you notify Miss Strachan of the days that your child will be walking home.

Social Distancing

We'd like to remind all parents and carers to observe social distancing guidelines on the school yard. We have been notified that there have been some occasions this week where social distancing measures have not been observed. Please continue to be as vigilant as possible during drop off and pick up and observe social distancing measures at all times. To minimise risk further please stick to the allocated drop off and collection times, this will prevent parents and carers from waiting on the yard unnecessarily and maintain our staggered system. Please do not arrive on the school yard any earlier than **8.45 am** in the morning or **3 pm** in the afternoon. We thank you for you cooperation and understanding with this.

A reminder of the staggered start and end times are below:



Timings for the beginning of the day are as follows:

- Reception from 8:45am (Please take your child straight into Reception class via the ramp).
- Class 1 8.50am
- Class 2 8.55am

Please arrive promptly, observing social distancing measures at all times.

Children will be escorted into school via separate entrances to keep the class 'bubbles' separate.

Our timings for the end of day are as follows:

- Reception 3:05pm
- Class 1 3:10pm
- Class 2 3:15pm



Hand cream

Due to the enhanced hand washing procedure at school and home it may be that children start to notice their hands become dry and sore, especially as winter arrives. We'd like to prevent that from happening. We have purchased some E45 moisturiser for each class for children to use if they feel they begin to get dry hands. Please email admin@acomb.northumberland.sch.uk if you **do not** want your child to use it. We will ensure that the dispenser is used by an adult or sanitised between children.

Birthday Cakes

Due to the current guidelines we are no longer able to accept birthday cakes in school to share amongst children. Thank you for your understanding with this.

Coats

Please ensure your child has a warm, waterproof coat every day as we make the most of playtimes and outdoor learning whatever the weather!

Reading books

Following an overhaul of our reading scheme over the summer we are now using stages/levels rather than colour bands which is a much easier system to follow!

Teachers are currently issuing reading books to children; do not be alarmed if your child's reading stage has changed or gone down a level. It is important they are reading a book confidently and fluently, it is normal to see a change in children's reading ability following the six week summer holiday – this year the break has been much longer for some children so we fully expected to see a dip. We will be reading as much as possible in the coming weeks, please may we request you do the same – let's get off to a flying start!
