What Is a Homophone?

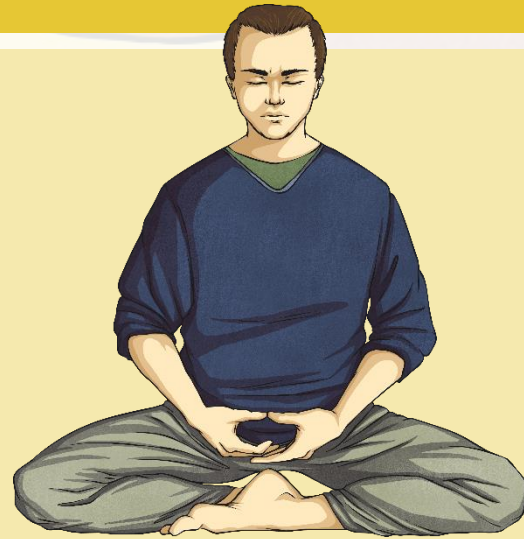
A homophone is a word that **sounds the same** as another word, but **its spelling or meaning is different**.
