#### **GDPR**

We are currently reviewing some of our systems to ensure we are GDPR compliant by 25<sup>th</sup> May. The GDPR relates to how personal data is stored and used. We will be sending out some new consent forms that reflect the new requirements in due course.

#### Attendance. Target 96%

As you are no doubt aware it is one of my responsibilities as headteacher to monitor attendance weekly and consider how attendance rates can be improved.

It has been a long winter and at the present time several children's attendance level is currently well below the expected level of 96%. I do understand that this is mainly due to illness. However as I am sure you will understand, this is a cause for concern. If a child misses a significant number of lessons, then they may fall behind the rest of the class in their academic progress, as well as losing touch with friends and teachers. I am hopeful that as the weather improves there will be less illness.

I appreciate that children fall ill and can be too unwell to come to school. However, if an ailment seems minor, please send your child to school; very often, children forget their symptoms in the course of a busy school day and staff will support them. If your child continues to feel unwell in school, then rest assured that staff will contact you and make the appropriate arrangements to return your child home.

I know that you will wish to support the school in our efforts to improve attendance for the benefit of the children. Therefore, in accordance with current guidelines, I suggest that if your child is ill and their attendance is below the expected figure of 96% you make an appointment with your GP; I would also request that proof of any medical appointments be sent to school so that I can authorise the absence. Appointment cards or prescriptions would be acceptable. It is <u>not</u> necessary to purchase a letter from your GP. Please do ensure you ring the school office on each day of absence to speak to Mrs Craig who is in school from 8.15am.

As always I wish to work with families to do the very best for your children and if there is anything that I can do to support you in this matter, please do not hesitate to get in touch.

Please note that family holidays cannot be taken in school time. If you should decide to go ahead with a request for term time absence please ask Mrs Craig or myself for the appropriate forms before booking any such holidays and a meeting with me will be arranged to discuss if there are any exceptional circumstances in line with the Local authority policies and Hexham partnership agreements.

Where appropriate I will be sending individual letters regarding your child's attendance and attendance reports to date and may ask you to come in for a meeting with myself to discuss how we can understand and support any attendance issues. If need be a referral to our Education Welfare Officer may be made on an individual basis where attendance is well below expectations.
