Reception - Mrs Manning

Reception are very enthusiastic about their dinosaur topic. We have been learning lots of tricky names and drawing, painting and making dinosaurs from all different materials. This week we have looked at fossils, made some fossils from salt dough and dug for bones in the soil. The children are focusing on counting, recognising and ordering numerals and numicon to 5. They have already learned lots of sounds in RWINc and are starting to read and write words!

Class 1 have had another great week. We have been learning all about Quality Question Starters, as part of this task we had to create our own questions for the characters from the story 'The Gruffalo'. The children were then able to take it in turns to play the different roles of the characters as part of a hot seating task. We have also been learning all about multiplication and using arrays to prove our answers. We then went on an autumn walk during science to collect leaves and apples, the children thoroughly enjoyed this and we are hoping to use our apples to do some cooking next week.

Class 2 have moved on from the age of the Dinosaurs to the Stone Age. There was lots of fantastic story writing and big numbers to understand. The children had a fantastic Prehistoric day with Roy up on the common and now know all about the differences between the Mesolithic and Neolithic period.
