Payment Information – Spring term

School Meals - January 2019 - Year 3 & 4 only

A school meal is available for your child at a cost of £2.20 per day, £11.00 per week. The cost for the first half of the spring term 2019 (up to week ending Thursday 14th February– 29 days) will be £63.80

Dinners can be paid for as follows:

- Half termly in advance by cheque or cash, payable on the first day of school £63.80
- Weekly by cash or cheque, payable on Monday each week £11.00

Swimming & Multisport – January 2019 – Year 1 to 4 only

The cost for the first half of the spring term (6 weeks up to Wednesday 13th February) will be £30 and can be paid for as follows:

- Half termly in advance by cheque or cash, payable on the first day of school £30.00
- Weekly by cash or cheque £5.00

Cheques should be made payable to 'Northumberland County Council'. Payments should be sent to school in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, the amount and what the payment is for.
