Safety and safeguarding update

Start of the day at 8.55am

After the Easter holiday there will be a change to our arrangements at the start of the day. Children who attend breakfast club will stay with Little Oaks staff until 8.55am when they will be taken directly to classrooms.

Reception children will be lining up on the yard with the other classes as they will be starting their first term when we gradually start the transition to year 1.

Please note that parents are responsible for their children until 8.55am when teachers and Learning Support Assistants will collect them from the yard. A member of staff will be available to take any important messages at 8.50am such as any changes to who is picking your child up from school.

End of the school day at 3.15pm.

Please come into the school yard rather than waiting beyond the fence.

Children are brought on to the yard and are sent to parents/carers when the adults have been seen by the school staff. It is very helpful if parents can make themselves visible.

The children are then the responsibility of their parents/carers. We have a few rules designed to keep the children safe which I am sure they can tell you about.

Bikes and scooters must not be ridden in the yard.

Walls, fences and furniture must not be climbed on or over at any time.

<u>Parking</u>

A trial parking plan around the school and Bishop's Hill area has been proposed by the Highways department which may be implemented in the near future. I will share any information I receive with you as I receive it.

Easter Science
