If working on paper, you could write a list of any examples of words you find in a table. For example,

Verbs	Nouns	Adjectives
clean	eggs	warm

Remember:

Nouns are naming words, they name places, things, or people.

Adjectives are describing words.

Verbs are action or doing words.
