PE kits

Blue shorts, white t-shirt and trainers for indoor PE. For colder days and outdoor PE children may come to school with blue jogging bottoms and jumper on top of their shorts and t-shirts. (This could be the navy blue Acomb Wentworth kit or similar if you have purchased it.) Where possible PE will be held outside unless the weather is really wet.

Forest School Kit

Long trousers, ideally jogging bottoms (not jeans) and a long sleeved top – this could also be the navy blue Acomb Wentworth kit or similar. Children should wear trainers and bring wellies and waterproofs in a carrier bag. School do have a supply of waterproofs for children to wear if you are unable to send them from home. More information will be coming home soon from Mrs Gray about Forest School sessions. Class two will be taking part in a forest school session this half term, we will be in touch once the date is finalised.

Please note Forest school starts next week with Mrs Gray, so all classes should wear **normal uniform tomorrow**.

Reception class will be having their first PE session on **Thursday** with Miss Dunlavy so should wear **PE kit** this Thursday.

Mr Thompson will be teaching PE to all classes this **Friday** so **PE kit** should be **worn by all classes**.

From **Monday 7th September** please follow the timetable above.
