Our P.E lessons have been amazing! We have all listened carefully to follow instructions and worked together as part of a team and in partners. I am very impressed with Class One's positive attitude to learning and their enthusiasm when reading both at school and at home.










Class 2 - Miss Strachan

Class Two have been diving into their topic of Castles and Knights. They have been making a timeline of British history, studying who invaded and when and exploring Motte and Bailey castles!

We have started our class text in English, John Drawbridge: A Medieval Knight in Training. We have been looking at what life was really like for a Norman knight in training - we decided it would be both exciting and tough! We have studied the features of diary entries and have begun writing our own diaries from the characters perspective using time adverbials.
