Welcome back everyone. We have a busy term ahead!

Year 2 Sats tests take place in May. (National end of key stage 1 tests.)

I would like to invite year 2 parents to an open session to find out about the Year 2 SATs tests that the children will be doing in May. I will give you an overview of the tests and other assessments and share how you can help your children. This session will take place on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> April from 5.30pm until 6pm. I hope this time will enable as many parents as possible to come along.

### Parking and road safety update.

Myself, Catherine Fergus and some governors have met with the highways representative for Highways and county councillor, Terry Robson with the aim of improving road safety for the children. A 20 mph speed limit is due to be implemented this term and we are hopeful that parking restrictions will be extended in the immediate school area. In the meantime, thank you for your cooperation in not parking on the zigzag lines or opposite the school site where the road is so narrow. The children enjoyed their road safety talks and should have brought home a leaflet.
